Key Issues / Themes / Messages	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Mentally Healthy Leeds, commissioned by LCC Public Health, commenced in April 2018 and provides a public service that promotes good mental health for everyone across Leeds. It aims to combat discrimination and stigma over mental health, and to reduce health inequalities and improve health and wellbeing, especially in the most deprived communities that are most at risk of poor mental health. 2. The new Community Based Mental Health Service, also funded by LCC, will commence in April 2019. As yet it doesn't have its user-facing name, but it will provide one service for Leeds with one website. It will be provided by 16 Delivery Network Partners, established organisations that will work together to cover all of Leeds. 3. The Leeds Health & Care Partnership Executive Group has agreed that the third sector will be asked to contribute at the highest levels to the delivery of the Leeds Health & Care Plan. The new Leeds Providers' Integrated Care Collaborative brings together the four NHS sectors (LCH, LTHT, LYPFT and the GP Confederation). LCC Adults and Health and the third sector will attend its meetings. LPICC will have one third-sector member (not yet chosen), though not a decision-making position.
Areas where additional support is required	<p>Engagement with the third sector and awareness of what it can and should contribute to the Leeds Plan are improving at the highest levels amongst those commissioning and providing health and care services in Leeds. There is always need and room for improvement, especially at ground level.</p>
