<p>Key Issues / Themes / Messages</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. LYPFT presented an update on the community model redesign. There is a separation of working age and older adults. The community offer for working age adults will be CMHTs, Crisis resolution and Intensive support. For older adults it will be CMHTs, Intensive home treatment, memory service and care home teams. 2. Overview of the new Committees in Common: Leeds Providers Integrated Care Collaborative. <p>The committee is made up of chairs and CEOs of LYPFT, LCH, LTHT and GP Confed. LCC and 3rd sector (Forum Central) also have a seat on the committee.</p> <p>The aim of the committee is to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Better integrate service delivery - Improve the quality of care - Improve patient outcomes/reduce inequalities - Make the best use of resources <p>Forum Central are currently advertising to recruit a 3rd sector rep for the committee.</p> 3. The CCG presented on 3 areas: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A new paradigm for commissioning (commissioning for outcomes with defined population, defined set of outcomes and defined budget). - Frailty and End of Life (outcomes framework for people living with frailty and end of life (plan to separate the two as different needs) - Population Health Management (Leeds identified as one of 4 national sites. Will be developing a 20 week programme to broaden understanding of PHM. Programme will run January – March 2019)
