Key Issues / Themes / Messages	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Community Mental Health Services: Separation of services for working age and older people. Recognition that with the current all age adult service older people are under represented. Management of change programme on-going with intention of new services being established from March 2019.2. LPICC Committees in Common; three priority issues:<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Frailty• LCPs• Outpatients3. Developing Population Health Management Capabilities: Leeds chosen as one of 4 sites by NHSE. Expected that learning from Leeds will be shared across the West Yorkshire & Harrogate STP. Focus will be Frailty and End of Life as the population chosen as priority for Leeds PHM. 20-week programme will work with 4 LCPs.4. Discussion about Urgent Care – highlighted the complexity moving from the current way of working (~purchaser / provider split, competitive procurement) and to new ways of working with commissioners and providers working together to develop new models. Leeds CCG have issued a Procurement Prior Information Notification (PIN) for Urgent Care but were not able to give detail at PPB because of requirement to give same information to all potential providers.
