<p>Key Issues / Themes / Messages</p>	<p>1. Leeds has been selected as one of 4 areas to implement an accelerated PHM Programme. In Leeds the focus is on frailty. The PHM Programme looks at population data and uses this to improve quality. The funded programme is for 20 weeks and the idea is to analyse the data in 4 areas of Leeds and come up with individual interventions depending on the needs identified in each area. Following the 20 weeks it is intended that the principles would be rolled out across the City.</p> <p>PHM Programme started w/c 07/01/19</p> <p>2. 4 LCGs (Local Clinical Groups) have been selected based on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • no. of frail people in the area • deprivation • interest (i.e. frailty has already been identified as a priority) • level of development of the LCP. <p>LCPs to participate are Seacroft, Woodsley, Pudsey and Garforth.</p> <p>3. The 4 LCPs have £50K each to support the work required for the 20 week accelerated project. They also get training and mentoring from Optum (consultant leading the project). LCPs will take ideas to a subgroup of the Clinical Strategy Group (CSG) for frailty. There will be a representative from each partner on the subgroup.
