<p>Key Issues/Themes/Messages</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Community Pharmacy – Ruth Buchan (CEO Community Pharmacy West Yorkshire) presented on the role of community pharmacy within Leeds and the opportunities for more integrated primary health care that the network of pharmacies may provide. Ruth highlighted three areas for future development; <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Supporting long-term conditions • First point of contact for primary care needs • Developing a wider role as a community hub focused on health and well being. <p>Community pharmacists are now engaging with LCPs with a view to ensuring that local services are integrated.</p> 2. Leeds Technology Offer – Alastair Cartwright (City Digital Partnerships) provided an overview of the work that is underway to bring together digital support via a single service desk for Leeds City Council, Leeds Community Health and GPs. He also outlined the investment plans in Leeds which include move towards 5G super fast broadband and the deployment of ‘smart’ devices within social housing (for example to detect damp so as to facilitate speedy repair reducing the negative impact on health). The drive to digitization of health care is on-going; there is a recognition that more needs to be done to ensure that groups and individuals who are currently digitally excluded are not left behind, the currently lending scheme, whilst a positive move is currently limited in its reach. 3. Long Term Conditions Board – Lindsay Springall updated the PPB on the status of the LTC Board. The Board has agreed the programme of work for the next five years and the outcomes that it intends to achieve. I will be joining this Board with effect from April so will provide a more detailed update after the next meeting on 8 April 2019. 4. Population Health Management – Lucy Jackson provide a brief update on progress. All selected LCPs appear to actively engaged; the second workshop focusing on ‘Targeting & Developing outcomes’ takes place on 26/2; a full programme update will be circulated by the PHM team shortly.
