| <b>Key Issues / Themes / Messages</b>             | <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Update on West Yorkshire and Harrogate Partnership. WYHP is ahead of many other areas although clearly still significant challenges. Primacy of Place remains – only do at a partnership level what is necessary and can't be done at the level of Place (Leeds). Lots of discussion about funding across the partnership.</li><li>2. Leeds Health and Care Plan obsessions worked on further – still in draft but focus on three key areas of Prevention, Home First and Mental Health. Cross cutting themes still hugely important, particularly workforce. Work likely to be structured using a life course approach (similar to Leeds Health &amp; Wellbeing Strategy) Home First now meeting as a separate work stream</li><li>3. Communications plan – a lot has been delivered – plan moving forward to build communications plan around obsessions and also to be more closely aligned with HWB Strategy in terms of presentation. To focus on fewer consistent messages rather than trying to cover everything.</li></ol> |
