Key Issues / Themes / Messages	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. LCPs, Kim Adams outlined progress on the LCPs with Thea Stein supporting on how to integrate this agenda into communities.2. The Leeds Plan was updated with draft plan being discussed and ideas for inclusion of all sectors. I asked for a dedicated 3rd sector Board2Board session in Sept 2020 which was warmly received so that we can show how we can support the left shift. Also stressed importance of full cost recovery and that we were not the “cheap option”.3. West Yorks and Harrogate 5 year Plan discussed with lots of conversation about what the left shift means and focus away from always meaning no growth for statutory – this was particularly the case for LTHT who felt the new capital spend at the hospital meant spend generally on acute needed to increase, but that they also supported more funding of third sector too.
