
## Forum Central, Suite C24 Joseph's Well, Hanover Walk, Leeds LS3 1AB



Forum Central is based in Joseph's Well, a short distance from the city centre. If walking from the city centre, head towards the Town Hall and then up Calverley St. turning left at Portland Street before continuing along Gt. George Street, passing Leeds General Infirmary and St George's Crypt, before crossing the foot bridge over the Inner Ring Road (A58).

**By Bus:** The 49, 50 & 50A, 19 & 19A all stop at Park Lane College which is just across the road from Joseph's Well.

You can catch the number 5 bus (fare £1) outside Leeds Train Station and get off at Park Lane College, then cross the road to Joseph's Well car park. For more information visit: <a href="https://www.wymetro.com/BusTravel/Leeds/">https://www.wymetro.com/BusTravel/Leeds/</a>

Enter the building via the entrance nearest the car park barrier – see below.

**Parking:** Joseph's Well has free visitor parking for up to 2 hours. If you wish to use to use this facility please contact us before you arrive as we need your name, time of arrival and you car registration number in order to book a parking slot. There is also disabled parking. You can enter the building via the entrance nearest the car park barrier.

**Once inside**: If you enter the building via the 'Main Entrance' which is usually staffed by a commissionaire, and is near the Well Pub (now closed down), access to Forum Central is via the stairs, or the lift to floor C. On floor C follow signs to C24.

If you enter via the main car park using the security barrier, park near the barrier and enter the building via the door nearest to the commissionaire's hut. From here take the stairs or lift to floor C and come along the corridor to C24 - it's not far.

**Level Access**: If you require level access you will need to enter via the main car park as above. The door nearest the commissionaire's hut opens automatically, and the lift is just opposite.
